

# Instructions to Authors

All material submitted for publication is assumed to be submitted exclusively to the Journal of Tropical Pediatrics unless the contrary is stated. Papers will normally be sent to referees and will be checked for the statistics quoted before acceptance. Time of publication and priority are decided by the Editors who retain the customary right to make corrections in style and, if necessary, shorten material accepted for publication.

Original articles are usually not more than 2000 words long with no more than six tables or illustrations. They should normally report original research of relevance to clinical or community paediatrics, or maternal and child health, or describe innovative approaches to delivery of health care. Occasional Reviews are usually by invitation and not more than 3000 words long. Personal Practice articles and contributions to Perspectives in Primary Care are short articles usually of 1000 words. Letters to the Editor should normally be of not more than 500 words and should not carry more than five references.

## **Manuscripts, tables and illustrations**

Manuscripts should be typed, double-spaced, on one side of paper with a 5 cm margin on the left-hand side of the sheet. Tables and illustrations should be

submitted separate from the text of the paper. All illustrations should be supplied as prints on glossy paper, and the legend clearly written on the back in pencil.

## **References**

References should be numbered in the order in which they appear in the text. At the end of the article the full list of references should give the name and initials of all authors unless there are more than six, in which case the names of the first three authors should be given, followed by *et al.* The authors' names are followed by the title of the article, the title of the journal (abbreviated according to the style of *Index Medicus*), the year of publication, the volume number and the first and last page numbers. Titles of books should be followed by the place of publication, the publisher and the year.

## **Proofs and offprints**

Proof corrections should be kept to a minimum and should conform to the style indicated by the publishers and enclosed with the proofs. 20 offprints are sent to the author(s) free of charge on publication. A scale of fees will apply to offprints ordered in excess of this number and is included with the proofs.
