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Manuscripts and letters will be acknowledged. Those not accepted for publication will be returned if a stamped addressed envelope is enclosed for their return.

Authors should give their names and initials and the posts at the time they did the work. Full address of the corresponding author must be included.

Original papers should not usually be more than 2000 words in length; brief reports and letters should not be more than 1000 words.

Typing should be on one side of the paper, with double spacing between the lines and margins of 5 cm at the top and bottom.

SI units should be used for scientific measurements.

Statistical procedures should be described in the Methods section. References should be provided for the computer software used, if any.

Tables, figure legends, and illustrations should be on separate sheets and these should be no more than six.

References should be written in the Vancouver style, and numbered in the order in which they appear in the text.

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
