

Instructions to Authors

Submission of Manuscripts

The manuscript should be submitted directly to the nearer of the two Editors:

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All submitted papers are seen by at least two referees who give an opinion about acceptability on the basis of originality, scientific reliability of the study, analyses of the data and interpretation of the results. Statistical opinion is sought on potentially acceptable papers with regard to design and conduct of the study as well as statistical inferences. Manuscripts and letters will be acknowledged. Those not accepted for publication will be returned if a stamped addressed envelope is enclosed. Submission of a paper implies that it reports unpublished work and that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. If previously published tables, illustrations, or more than 200 words of text are to be included, then the copyright holder's written permission must be obtained. Copies of any such permission letters should be enclosed with the paper. Whenever possible, manuscripts should be submitted on floppy disc in addition to hard copy. Whilst the publishers can accept most computer and word processor discs, the preferred combinations are either PC MS-DOS, PC WINDOWS, or APPLE MAC, and either Microsoft Word or Wordperfect.

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
